- Team collaboration workflows, free hosting options, project publishing, and final polishing techniques for successful submissions.

This session is highly recommended for EdTech Innovation Club patrons, Teachers mentoring learner innovation projects, School web administrators, Student innovation team leaders and all educators (primary /secondary / tertiary) interested in practical digital projects creation.

In addition to the workshop above, attendees will participate in several other exciting sessions and activities throughout the two-day event including talks, hands-on workshops, networking opportunities, Contributor Day activities, AI and WordPress discussions, and collaborative social impact projects such as building websites for schools and educational institutions.
